About The Program

Future Leaders Program participants are asked to commit to attend all six meetings. Each session will provide five two-hour sessions, followed by a reception or social event for conversation and networking with the speaker, guests, and other participants. The March 2005 session will be a Recognition Program to be held in conjunction with ACEC/G's Monthly Membership lunch meeting. Because times and venues are varied, please refer to the schedule as indicated and future announcements.

Participation Fee

The participation fee is \$600 for first attendee and \$550 for additional attendee(s) from the same firm. The fee covers the administrative and program costs of each session, receptions, the ACEC/G March lunch meeting, and miscellaneous planned activities. For the programs to be beneficial, the participant should attend all meetings and arrive promptly. The ala-carte participation fee for *previous* FLP graduates *only* is \$100 per session. Previous graduates will be invited to participate under separate cover.

Benefits of The Future Leaders Program

Participants are eligible for 2 PDHs per meeting for a total of **12 PDHs**. Certificates will be awarded to attendees at the March session.

Participants will have the opportunity to develop **strong leadership skills and techniques**.
