About The Program

Future Leaders Program participants are asked to commit to attend all meetings (A seventh session has been added to this year's program.) Each session will provide six two-hour sessions, followed by a reception or social event for conversation and networking with the speaker, guests, and other participants. The April 2006 session will be a Recognition Program to be held in conjunction with ACEC/G's Monthly Membership lunch meeting. Because times and venues are varied, please refer to the schedule on the back and future announcements.

Participation Fee

The participation fee is \$650 for first attendee and \$550 for additional attendee(s) from the same firm. The fee covers the administrative and program costs of each session, receptions, the ACEC/G April lunch meeting, and miscellaneous planned activities. For the programs to be beneficial, the participant should attend all meetings and arrive promptly. The ala-carte participation fee for *previous* FLP graduates *only* is \$100 per session. Previous graduates will be invited to participate under separate cover.
