Who May Participate In the Future Leaders Program?

The ACEC/G Future Leaders Program is targeted to all rising industry professionals. Nominees must be employed by a member firm or be the owner/principal of the member firm. A firm may nominate as many eligible participants as they wish. The 2008-09 Program runs from September 2008 to May 2009 and includes a commitment to six sessions and a recognition program at the ACEC/G May General Membership Meeting. All previous FLP graduates are invited and encouraged to participate in any of the upcoming FLP sessions on an ala-carte basis.

During the past 10 years we have presented outstanding learning opportunities with topics by leading experts in our industry. This year, we are happy to continue in that process and present a program of events that will help prepare participants for future leadership roles. Each session has been structured to provide participants with the opportunity to learn, interact and network with their peers and some of our industry's leading experts, while having fun. The FLP series also provides participants with meaningful PDH opportunities and valuable reference materials to take back to their firms. Graduates of the FLP will also be afforded the opportunity to participate in the recently formed Young Leaders Forum intended to promote ongoing networking opportunities and participation in ACEC/G events.

About The Program

Future Leaders Program participants are asked to commit to attend all meetings. Each session will provide six two-hour sessions, followed by a reception or social event for conversation and networking with the speaker, guests, and other participants. The May 2009 session will be a Recognition Program to be held in conjunction with ACEC/G's Board of Directors and Monthly Membership meeting. Because times and venues are varied, please refer to the schedule on the back and future announcements.

Participation Fee

The participation fee is \$750 for the first attendee and \$700 for additional attendee(s) from the same firm. The fee covers the administrative and program costs of each session, receptions, the ACEC/G May lunch meeting, and miscellaneous planned activities. For the programs to be beneficial, the participant should attend meetings and arrive promptly. The ala-carte participation fee for previous FLP graduates is \$125 per session. Previous graduates will be invited to participate under separate cover.

Benefits of the Future Leaders Program

- Participants are eligible for 2 PDHs per meeting for a total of **14 PDHs**. Certificates will be awarded to attendees at the May session.
- Participants will have the opportunity to develop **strong leadership skills and techniques**.
- Participants will be provided with **industry knowledge** needed to meet the challenges ahead.
- Participants will better understand **the role ACEC/G plays in the industry** and how the Council's services can help their firm.
- Participants will have an opportunity to **network** and exchange information with others about issues that face them daily.
