About The Program

Future Leaders Program participants are asked to commit to attend all meetings. Each session will provide six two-hour sessions, followed by a reception or social event for conversation and networking with the speaker, guests, and other participants. The April 2011 session will be a Recognition Program to be held in conjunction with ACEC/G's Board of Directors and Monthly Membership meeting. Participation Fee

The participation fee is \$700 for the first attendee and \$650 for additional attendee(s) from the same firm. The fee covers the administrative and program costs of each session, receptions, the ACEC/G April lunch meeting, and miscellaneous planned activities. For the programs to be beneficial, the participant should attend meetings and arrive promptly. The ala-carte participation fee for *previous* FLP graduates is \$125 per session. Previous graduates are invited to participate.
